“Grandmother of Juneteenth”

**Opal Lee’s** life has been defined by one date: June 19, 1865, a date when Union soldiers arrived in Texas in 1865 to tell the enslaved people of the state of that the Emancipation Proclamation had granted them their freedom

It was an act of racist brutality 82 years earlier on June 19, when Lee was just 12 years old, that helped shape her into a civil rights crusader. Lee became widely known in the 21st century as the “Grandmother of Juneteenth” for her role in having the date made a national holiday in 2021.
