Rent payments are due on the 1st business day of each month and late on the 6th business day of each month. The last day to pay rent is May 12, 2025. On Tuesday, May 13, 2025, a \$25.00 LATE FEE will be posted to all unpaid accounts. This includes maintenance charges owed and unpaid agreements. Payments made after May 12, 2025, will be considered late. On May 26, 2025, a Dispossessory will be filed.

Here are some tips to help your joint pain and arthritis to be manageable.

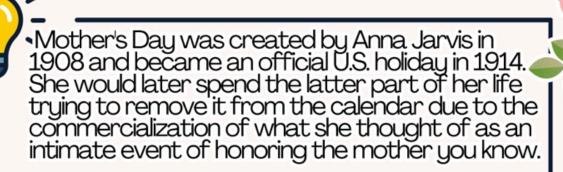
Get active. It's a common misconception that if you have arthritis, you cannot exercise. That's just not true. Try some low impact exercises like walking or yoga.

#### NATIONAL DAY OF AWARENESS OF MISSING AND MURDERED INDIGENOUS WOMEN AND GIRLS

May 5th being declared as National Day of Awareness of Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls was a direct response to the demands for justice following the 2013 murder of Hanna Harris on the Northern Cheyenne Reservation. Due to an inadequate law enforcement response, Hanna's family and friends were forced to conduct their own search. Their relentless pursuit of justice sparked community-led marches and advocacy efforts, not only for Hanna, but for the countless cases that remain unresolved. Since 2017, the national movement to end violence against Indigenous women has continued to elevate May 5th as a day of remembrance, action, and advocacy.

Mental Health Awareness Month was established in 1949 to increase awareness of the importance of mental health and wellness in Americans' lives and to celebrate recovery from mental illness.
